New Features

EDIUS

- Skipped Frames setting on the Preview window will now be retained even after closing the project
- Improved ability to recover and open corrupted project files
- Added a feature to display a warning message about the expiration of floating licenses on EDIUS PCs configured to use floating licenses.
*To enable this feature, it is required to check [Show License Expiration Warning] option and uncheck [Warning of the floating license is not displayed] option in GV License Manager settings on each EDIUS PC.

Fixed Issues

EDIUS

- When editing a clip in the Properties view, in rare cases after selecting an input field, keystrokes are treated as shortcut keys instead of entering text
- Thumbnails for clips that go offline will not reappear when the clips come back online
- Dropping a folder from Explorer to the Bin window creates multiple folders with the same name in the Bin
- There are cases that the “Cancel” button on the progress dialog transiently changes to an “OK” button just before completion, and clicking it will cause EDIUS to freeze (SFDC00907707)
- EDIUS fails to start with the error “Failed to start services. (Render Service)” (SFDC00905819)
- Certain .MPG files and .MP4 files created by Adobe Premiere Pro 2025 are unable to be imported properly (SFDC00909994)

Mync

- Quick Titler files cannot be registered to Mync directly and registered files via EDIUS are shown in low resolution
- Certain .MPG files and .MP4 files created by Adobe Premiere Pro 2025 are unable to be imported properly (SFDC00909994)
